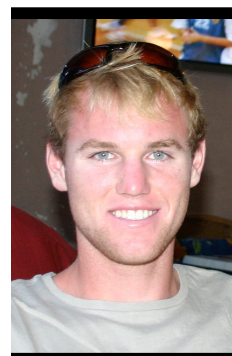

# Tim Hornsby

*...in depth*



Inspired by the 1996 Olympic Games in his hometown of Atlanta, Tim first took to the waters of Lake Lanier at just eleven years old. He has since paddled his way around the globe and now has his sights set on making a splash for Team USA in London 2012.

Tim's breakout year was 2003 which culminated with a top 10 finish at World Championships and a fourth place result at the U.S. Olympic Trials for the team heading to Athens...all at 17 years old.

Tim went on to medal at the 2006 Pan-American Championships (bronze) then took silver at the 2007 World Cup in Szeged, Hungary before winning the 2008 U.S. Olympic Trials in both the k2 500 meter race and the k4 1000 meter event. He has been the U.S. National Champion every year since 1997, is a long time member of the U.S. National Team and is the #1 ranked American paddler.

Upon graduating high school, Tim was accepted to the University of California San Diego, Jacob's School of Engineering where he is currently juggling studies in Aerospace Engineering with training full time at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in nearby Chula Vista.
